



There are going to be some changes to harm reduction in the city after April 1st, and this zine hopes to give as much information as possible so we can keep ourselves and each other safe.

will close by March 31, 2025. In Toronto, we are losing six sites.

## Legal Challenge:

The Neighbourhood Group Community Services (TNG) and two individuals are challenging Ontario's Bill 223 Community Care and Recovery Act (CCRA), arguing it violates Charter rights and exceeds provincial authority. They are arguing that the law is discriminatory, and that forcing SCS closures dangerously increases overdose risks. If the challenge is successful, SCSs could continue operating. The case has major implications for public health, drug policy, and government control over supervised consumption sites. The court heard the challenges on March 25 and 26, and on March 28 granted an injunction so that SCSs could continue to operate until a final decision is made.



Injunction: What does that mean?
On March 28 2025 the Ontario Superior
Court issued an injunction allowing
safe consumption sites to stay open
until the Court rules on Bill 223.

An injunction is a court order that stops someone from doing something or forces them to do something, usually temporarily, until a final decision is made.

The injunction only covers restrictions near schools, not the closure of municipally funded sites. Provincial funding isn't guaranteed, and municipalities can't step in. Some of the sites may be able to continue to operate, but as it stands, many are still closing.

Until the case is fully settled, it is unclear which sites that were slated to close will continue to operate.


